SUMMER SADDLE UP ADULT CLINIC SESSION DESCRIPTIONS



UN-MOUNTED SESSIONS will be held throughout the Summer Saddle Up. Adults are invited to attend any of these unmounted sessions. Topics included in the sessions may include clipping, grooming, braiding, horse show terms, conformation, terminology, saddle fitting, equine nutrition, saddle fitting etc...

WESTERN

WESTERN STOCKSEAT - Emphasis on riders' position - seat, legs, head and hands while riding western gaits. Walk, jog, lope, stop. Straight lines. Use of legs for turning. Cone/Pattern work if time permits

WESTERN RANCH PLEASURE - Walk, jog-trot extended trot, lope, extended lope, back, turn. How to ride a working Ranch Horse pleasure class. Consistency and correct movement of a Working Ranch Horse

WESTERN PLEASURE - Class specification, procedures, rules, required gaits. Walk, jog, lope, reverse, stop, back. Attire & appointments

WESTERN TRAIL OBSTACLES - riders are invited to observe ground exercises with the youth i.e. 'Setting a Trail Course' 'Approaching Trail Obstacles' 'Walk-a-trail Course. Participants will ride in mounted class and work on how to navigate trail obstacles on their own horse.

HUNTER (NO JUMPS)

HUNTSEAT - Emphasis on riders correct position and effectiveness using seat, legs, head and hands while riding Huntseat. Walk, Trot, Canter, Diagonals, 2-point, sitting trot etc.

HUNTER PLEASURE A - Class specifications/procedure, rules, qualifying gaits, use of ring. Walk, Trot, halt, reverse. Tempos, Entering the arena.

HUNTER PLEASURE B - Manners & attitude, credits & faults, proper contact, transitions Walk, trot, canter, transitions, consistency. [Riders may choose between this class or the Sport Horse Under Saddle class]

SPORT HORSE UNDER SADDLE – Class routine Walk, Trot, Canter, Hand Gallop, Appointments

HUNTER PLEASURE & SPORT HORSE UNDER SADDLE PRACTICE-A-CLASS in small groups of 3 or 4 riders will go through a Hunter Pleasure class routine walk, trot, canter, hand gallop while receiving constructive criticism to aid them. Attire and Appointments will be discussed.

HUNTER OVER FENCES - 'HOF' - ALL CLASSES TO JUMP

HOF GRIDWORK gymnastics with emphasis on position through the poles and grid

HOF COURSEWORK I single fences, outside lines, takeoff spots, strides, start circles.

HOF COURSEWORK II inside lines, take-off spots, striding between fences, going 'deep', end circles

HOF RIDE-A-COURSE [practice course] riders are given practical critiques while riding a Hunter-Over-Fences course appropriate for their level. One round only

DRESSAGE

DRESSAGE TEMPOS AND TRANSTIONS - walk - halt, walk - trot, directional changes (leg positioning) trot-canter, canter-trot, in-gait transitions, tempo and rhythm.

DRESSAGE SCHOOL MOVEMENTS A – corners, centerlines, and diagonals HXF & MXK (trot work) circles, one-loop & multiple-loop serpentines

DRESSAGE SCHOOL MOVEWMENTS B – halt and salute, across the school, half circles, lengthening.

DRESSAGE RIDE-A-TEST [practice test ride] riders are given practical critiques while riding a test of their choice – reader will be available. Parents are invited to learn how to read a test for a rider

HORSEMANSHIP – any horse, any saddle, gaited, non-gaited. Emphasis will be on safety, riders position, balance of the horse and rider

HORSEMANSHIP I riders position and balance in the saddle. Effectiveness using seat, legs, head and hands while riding. Tempos

HORSEMANSHIP II gaits, transitions and tempos, directional changes, rhythm

HORSEMANSHIP III utilization of legs and seat - introduce cone work and patterns

HORSEMANSHIP practicum Riders will complete a prescribed pattern while receiving feedback
