



Teal: Riders Showing in Training Level Tests 1, 2, 3, or 4

Riders showing in First Level and up.

School movements session A – corners, centerlines, and diagonals HXF & MXK (trot work)

School movements session B - circles, serpentines, half circles

School movements session C - halt and salute, across the school, circles, lengthening.
