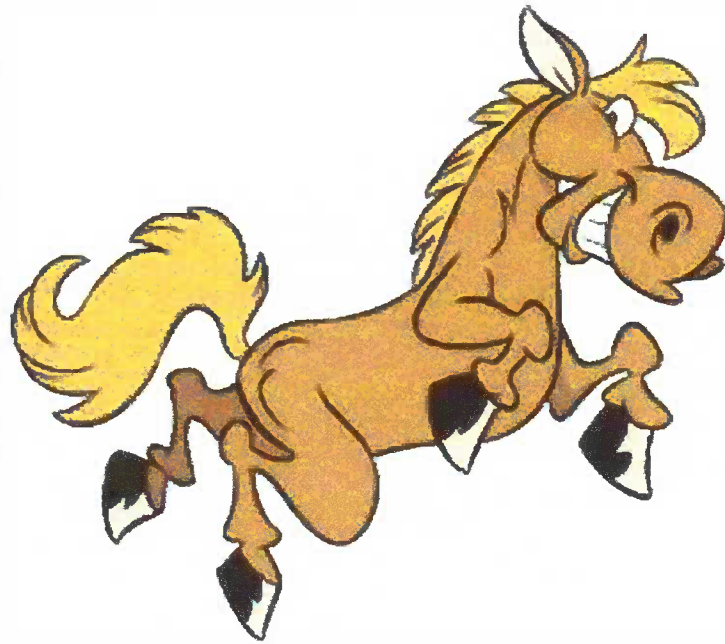

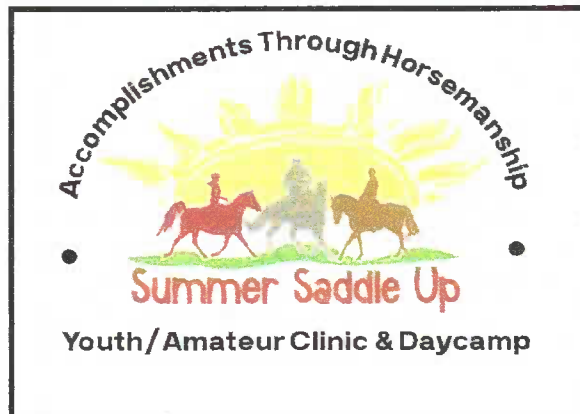

SUMMER SADDLE UP YOUTH CLINIC DRESSAGE



Rider Levels

Purple: Riders of any skill level who are new to dressage
Riders showing USDF Walk/Trot tests A, B, or C.

Teal: Riders Showing in Training Level Tests 1, 2, 3, or 4
Riders showing in First Level and up.

School movements session A – corners, centerlines, and diagonals HXF & MXK (trot work)

School movements session B – circles, serpentines, half circles

School movements session C – halt and salute, across the school, circles, lengthening.

Transitions session A – Walk- halt, walk – trot, directional changes (leg positioning)

Transitions session B – in-gait transitions, tempo and rhythm, trot-canter, canter-trot.

Introduction to dressage – anyone who is thinking of trying dressage – here is your chance to come over and try it. Basics, rhythms and gaits.

Dressage Equitation – How to ride ‘Dressage Equitation Class’ – Balanced seat position; class routine; rules.

Western Dressage - Ride dressage in a western saddle! Here is your chance to come and try dressage in a western saddle. Ride and learn the basics, rhythms and gaits. **Western Only.**

Ride-A-Test – [practice test ride] riders are given practical critiques while riding a test of their choice – reader will be available. Parents are invited to learn how to read a test for a rider.

Hunter-Over-Fences Session Descriptions



Grid-work session I – gymnastics with emphasis on position through the poles and grid

Grid-work session II – strides, tempo, counting strides, correct position through the grid. *

*Note -Pre-requisite for this class is participation in Gridwork session I

Coursework session I – single fences, outside lines, takeoff spots, strides, start circles.

Coursework session II – inside lines, takeoff spots, striding between fences, end/trot circles

Coursework session III – In-&-outs, broken lines, connecting lines, takeoff spots, 'going deep'.

HOF Flat Class – How to ride a Hunter over Fences division flat class - NO JUMPS.
Rules, regulations, class routine, attire and equipment

Ride-A-Course – [**practice course**] riders are given practical critiques while riding a Hunter-Over-Fences course appropriate for their level. One round only – additional rounds at the clinicians discretion.

Rider Levels – Teal, Lime, Purple

[Clinicians may recommend that a rider move to a different level clinic thru-out clinic]

HOF level Purple: Riders going over ground poles and cross-rails to 18”
[an adult leader is welcome for riders and horses starting ground poles].

HOF level Lime: Riders & horses 2’ cross rails and straight rails.
(due to numbers may be divided into two groups - A & B)

HOF level Teal: Riders & horses currently showing 2’3” & over.

Hunter Pleasure & Huntseat on the flat (No Jumps)

Session Descriptions

Hunter Pleasure Session A – Class specifications/procedure, rules, qualifying gaits, use of ring, walk, trot, halt, reverse, entering the ring.

Hunter Pleasure Session B – Manners & attitude, credits & faults, proper contact, transitions – Walk, trot, canter, transitions, consistency

Hunter Pleasure Session C - trot-canter, canter-trot, hand gallop, class routine, line up, back. Attire & Appointments

Huntseat (no Jumps) Session I – Riders' position - Head, Hands, Heels. Rules & class procedure. Halt, 2-point, diagonals, sitting trot, questions.

Huntseat (no Jumps) Session II – Riders' Position, Patterns & Tests, leads, simple-changes, figure-8 pattern, ride w/out stirrups (advanced riders only)

Show Hack – Class routine, rules, gait requirements, in-gait transitions

Sport Horse U/S (Under Saddle)- Class Routine, Rules, gait requirements, Walk, Trot & Canter

Rider Levels – Teal, Lime, Purple

Huntseat level PURPLE - Riders & horses who are new to Hunter Pleasure & Huntseat & Riders showing Walk-Trot and/or 10 & Under

Trail Class & Sport Horse Session Descriptions

TRAIL

Setting a Trail Course – ALL LEVELS – Unmounted session. How to set up a trail course. Types of obstacles, spacing, safety. Participants will help to set up the trail course they will ride over in their clinic. Western or English. Youth and Adults may attend

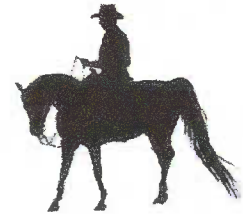
